It's been a great term at Loxley, thanks so much to all involved in our school community and here's to continued success in 2022!









Preparing for All Eventualities in January

First and foremost, it's very important for me to state that we are <u>planning</u> to re-open school as normal on Tuesday 4th January 2022.

The school has been given no other indication that we may have to move to remote learning other than what can be gleaned on the media. However, after last year's short notice change to arrangements for children's learning and in light of the recent rapid increase in cases and action being taken in Wales, we want to make sure that we are ready for all eventualities.

It is with this in mind, that all children will be taking home an exercise book and Seesaw login codes today. (Some parents may already have been given the login codes by their class teacher.) Your class teacher may also be sending home other key materials they believe your child would need should there be enforced school closures. All these items may also be useful if your child has to isolate due to Covid 19. In addition, your child may be taking reading books and homework for home learning over the Christmas holidays that may also be useful should there be school closures in the new school term.

I whole heartedly hope that we do open as normal after the Christmas holidays.
