Ministerial Visit to Loxley

On Friday, we had a ministerial fact finding visit from Damian Hinds the new Minister for Schools and a representative from the Department for Education (DfE). We were selected as a high performing primary school only one of seven to be chosen in the country I believe. I was told that the reason for Loxley being chosen was school performance data (including attainment and attendance data) and conversations the DfE have had with Jim Dugmore (Peak Edge MAT's CEO). It was a great opportunity to showcase some of the work we have been doing at Loxley in order to help other schools and to have access to the minister to discuss government actions we think would help primary schools across the country.

I could not have been any more proud of all the children at Loxley during the visit; their excellent learning behaviour, enthusiasm and interest shone through. The minister saw first hand, local history learning in Y5 where the children sang a song about the Sheffield flood brilliantly, times table learning in Y4, Reading



Buddies work in Year 2, continuous provision and phonics in Reception and much more. The Department of Education have written back to us to let us know how much they enjoyed the visit and how useful it was.

The reason for the Department of Education flagging up Loxley Primary School's excellence is down to everyone in Loxley's community so I want to thank, staff, parents and governors for all their tremendous work.
