Our Learning this half term	
Reading	Douglas Deep Sea Diary, The Atlas of Oceans Adventures, Looking at Non-Fiction and Fiction in our reading lessons. We will be answering a range of questions on these texts via comprehension lessons to explore vocabulary, predictions, authors intent and characters actions. Children will also be able to take a home a 'love of reading' book from our library box every Friday, to be returned when you are finished reading it, to help develop a love of reading.
Writing	Flotsam, The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch. Writing narrative, based on our own interpretation of an event (Flotsam) and retelling a story altering an element of the story (Light House Keepers Lunch) We will also be Developing a good handwriting style using cursive script.
Maths	Our main focus will be <i>Place Value</i> - Recognise the place value of each digit in a 2-digit number (tens, ones); Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs; Use place value and number facts to solve problems. We will also be learning to read and write numbers in words.
Science	Materials- Build on learning from Y1 about different materials and their properties. Consider the properties of materials and how these properties make materials useful for different purposes. our inventions with appropriate materials.
Geography	Continents and Oceans, knowing the 7 continents and 5 oceans. Looking at maps and globes finding locations on maps and globes. Can we find hot and cold climates on a map and find the equator.
RE	Belonging- what makes people feel they belong in a religion and how do they show that? Focusing on Islam.
Art	Creating clay pots. Working with a tactile medium (clay) to mould, sculpt and paint a pot.
Computing	Learning our logins and how to input our usernames and passwords. Using a QWERTY keyboard, using a mouse and why we need passwords and how to keep ourselves safe.
PE	Ball skills using hands- working up to netball and basketball.

PSHE We will start this half term looking at the unit around 'families and relationships'. Learning that families are

composed of different people. Learning how other people show their feelings and how to respond to them.
